Third Grade Education & Third Grade Title 1 Outreach Program

Designed to interface with the State of California Elementary Science Content Standards.

Serves over 6,500 students from 65 schools in eight school districts per year.

Program is conducted at the Reserve and in Title 1 low-to-moderate income schools.

Funds raised by the Foundation help cover the costs of buses, curriculum materials, staffing and volunteer training.



Middle School Research Project

Historic Grassland Restoration Project for 6th, 7th and 8th grade students.

SRPF project partnered with Murrieta Valley Unified School District and State Fish & Game Reserve Manager.

Students develop a plan that includes research, education and preservation elements to restore a one acre parcel on the Reserve.

Classrooms submit proposal for the solution and the school selected receives research grant from SRPF.

Project is written to assist middle school science classes to meet their California Elementary Science requirement.

Funds cover the cost of research materials, restoration tools, seeds and plants, buses, substitute release time, and supplies.

Third Grade & Middle School Quantitative Pre- and Post-Test Learning Program

A pre- and post-test has been developed and implemented by the Foundation to quantify the increase in natural science knowledge gained by the third grade students from the program. The test is based on five standard requirements in California's elementary science curriculum.

Conducted daily with all students participating in the program.

Funds cover data gathering, input, analyses and data base maintenance. Information is shared with classroom teachers, Reserve staff, Riverside County Parks Department and is used in grant writing to demonstrate the program's impact.
